**THOUGHT FOR TRINITY SUNDAY (15/16th June):** The words of today's gospel are an echo of the promises fulfilled last week at Pentecost. Only in the power of the Holy Spirit can we begin to approach the mystery which is the Trinity. Even then, we approach it not so that we can ever understand it, but so that we may stand in awe as we worship Father, Son and Holy Spirit.



**First Reading:** (Prov 8:22-31). This reading in praise of the wisdom of God can be seen as a struggle towards the revelation of the mystery of the Trinity.

**Second Reading:** (Rom 5:1-5). Christ made possible for us a loving relationship with God. This gives us the hope and sustains us in time of suffering.

**Gospel:** (Jn 16:12-15). The Holy Spirit helps the Church to grasp the full meaning of all Jesus said, especially what he said about the Father.

**THOUGHT FOR CORPUS CHRISTI (22nd/23rd June):** Corpus Christi reminds us that the presence of Christ is perennial and that he abides with us daily under the form of bread and wine. This presence, in the reserved sacrament, is rightly adored. But its main purpose is so that the sick may be joined with the wider community of believers through receiving Communion.



**First Reading:** (Gen 14:18-20). Melchizedek, a pagan priest-king, gives the gifts of bread and wine to Abraham. In Christian tradition that bread and wine were taken to prefigure the Eucharist.

**Second Reading:** (1 Cor 11:23-28). When we celebrate the Eucharist we do not merely make Christ present, but re-enact the death by which he saved us.

**Gospel:** (Lk 9:11-17) Jesus provides an extraordinary meal for those who followed him into the desert. In the Eucharist the Church continues the mission of Jesus - teaching, healing and nourishing God's people.

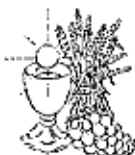
