

**THOUGHT FOR SS. PETER & PAUL (29/30th June):** Conditions were far from perfect when Peter and Paul began their mission of preaching the gospel. In an ideal world they might have wanted to wait for the "right" moment. We too are called to be fearless preachers of our beliefs, to make Christ known to our world, no matter what the time or place may be.



-  **1st Reading: (Acts 12:1-11).** We see how God looked after Peter and freed him from prison because he still had a lot more work to do.
-  **2nd Reading: (2 Tim 4:6-8,17-18).** Paul too realises that the Lord has been with him, and helped him 'fight the good fight'. He stood by him and rescued him.
-  **Gospel: (Mt 16:13-19).** This encounter with Jesus is built around Peter.

**THOUGHT FOR 14th Sunday of the Year (6/7th July):** It's a very single-minded Jesus who sends out the 72 disciples. They are to preach the Good News, and if people do not accept it, then they are to move on regardless. Are we able to be as confident with our faith today? Or do we find ourselves watering down what we believe so that it seems less radical than it really is?



-  **1st Reading: (Is 66:10-14).** This poem portrays a glowing picture of the blessings God will bestow on Jerusalem and its inhabitants.
-  **2nd Reading: (Gal 6:14-18).** The Christian life means becoming like Christ.
-  **Gospel: (Lk 10:1-12,17-20).** The sending out of the seventy-two disciples.

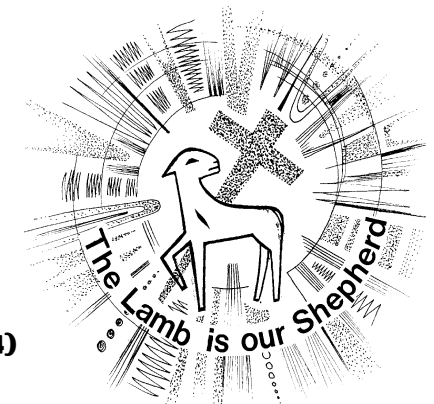
