THOUGHT FOR 21st SUNDAY OF THE YEAR (24/25th August): Every time we think we know the mind of God, we are confounded. God acts in ways which we cannot understand, because unlike God we are predictable. The kingdom of God, says Jesus, will be full of people that we wouldn't expect to see there. But by the



same token some people who would feel almost certain of their place may have a surprise when they knock at the door!

First Reading: (is 66:18-21). Gentiles will be converted and receive a share in Israel's blessings.

Second Reading: (Heb 12:5-7.11-13). As a father shows his concern for his son by training him in discipline, so God trains his children through suffering.

Gospel: (Lk 13:22-30) The Kingdom of God is offered, not just to the Jews, but to people from the four corners of the world.

THOUGHT FOR 22nd Sunday of the Year (31st Aug/1st Sep): It is far better to do some act of kindness for a person in an unobtrusive way, something that will go unnoticed by all except the One who sees everything. You might have to wait a while for your reward, but it will be great indeed.

First Reading: (Sir 3:17f). There is praise for the person who is humble.

Second Reading: (Heb 12:18f). This contrasts Mount Sinai, where the old covenant was made, and Mount Zion, which stands for the heavenly Jerusalem.

Gospel: (Lk 14:1.7-14). Jesus urges his followers not to covet places of honour, and always to act out of unselfish motives.


