Some DBS checks are taking a LONG time to come back, which is why we need to know now who wants to volunteer more than which slot you want to volunteer for. (Cooks do not need to be DBS checked.)

Following the pandemic, the number of Sacred Heart readers at Mass has fallen and there is an opportunity for others, young or old, to be added to the rota in the New Year. If you think this may appeal to you, please do stay on after Mass on Sunday 27th November for a chat and a short practice. Everyone is a little nervous to start with, so this will not commit you to joining the rota and you will be able to think it over if you wish. There will be another opportunity after Christmas for Saturday evening Mass.

People who are on any benefit, e.g. free school meals, universal credit or pension credit are eligible to use BCK. People can ring Chris or visit BCK on Friday between 12 and 2pm at Church Street, off Leonard Street Bingley with proof of the benefit they are on. Pay £5 for a bag of 15 items of food plus free foods donated from local shops and supermarkets.
