We need to check the **DBS** situation of each volunteer **as soon as possible.** Thank you. Some DBS checks are taking a LONG time to come back, which is why we need to know now who wants to volunteer more than which slot you want to volunteer for. (Cooks do not need to be DBS checked.)

People who are on any benefit, e.g. free school meals, universal credit or pension credit are eligible to use BCK.

People can ring Chris or visit BCK on Friday between 12 and 2pm at Church Street, off Leonard Street Bingley with proof of the benefit they are on. Pay £5 for a bag of 15 items of food plus free foods donated from local shops and supermarkets.

Bingley Food Bank is currently short of these items: Custard (tins or packets), Jam, Meat paste, Tea bags, Tins of Macaroni Cheese, Tins of Potatoes, Tins of Ravioli, Tins of Spaghetti. Not urgent but welcomed: Sugar.

But strong carrier bags are always needed! Thanks to everyone who has contributed for your generosity.
