Little Sisters Of The Poor - Sadly Mount St. Joseph's Care Home in Headingley, Leeds, run by the Little Sisters of the Poor, will have to close by the end of June 2024, due to the fact that RAAC (Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete) has been found throughout 95% of the roof of the home. Its condition is such that the home cannot continue to be used beyond next year. The present buildings, most of which were constructed in 1971, will need to be demolished. The Sisters have provided outstanding care for so many lay-people and clergy over many years. As a Diocesan family we owe the Sisters a great debt of gratitude.
